### Reviewer's report:

General

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Major Compulsory Revisions (that the author must respond to before a decision on publication can be reached)

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Minor Essential Revisions (such as missing labels on figures, or the wrong use of a term, which the author can be trusted to correct):

1. The authors should complete the article by including the following sections, which are currently missing: competing interests, authors' contributions, and acknowledgements.
2. In the abstract, the authors should provide the results of the significance tests for the differences between HIV positive and negative women (Table 2): either the OR and 95% CI (which I would prefer), or complement the prevalences given by providing exact p values)
3. The authors should put the references in BMC format
4. Was this study funded, and by who, or did the women pay for the tests done?
5. In 2nd paragraph of "Introduction", CDC = Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

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Discretionary Revisions (which the author can choose to ignore)

**What next?:** Accept after minor essential revisions

**Level of interest:** An article whose findings are important to those with closely related research interests

**Quality of written English:** Acceptable

**Statistical review:** No, the manuscript does not need to be seen by a statistician.
